INTRODUCTION

The Norm-Based Engagement Quarterly Report for Q1 2024 consists of five parts. The first part provides a description of ISS ESG's Norm-Based Engagement solution, which is conducted on behalf of investors with companies that have been assessed under ISS ESG's Norm-Based Research to be facing alleged or verified severe, systematic, or systemic failures to respect international norms and guidelines on responsible business conduct.

The latter sections of the report provide details of progress of engagement activities that were carried out on behalf of institutional investors in Q1 2024:

- The second part of the report presents summary statistics of engagements initiated in Q1 2024.
- The third part highlights notable engagements carried out in Q1 2024.
- The fourth part provides summaries of engagement responses received in Q1 2024.
- The fifth part provides an overview of responsiveness to letters sent out in Q1 2024, as of 31 March 2024.

ISS ESG NORM-BASED ENGAGEMENT APPROACH

ISS ESG's Norm-Based Engagement facilitates engagement with issuers on behalf of participating investors who would like to encourage corporate disclosure of efforts taken to manage or mitigate the environmental and social risks connected to business activities or operations. By engaging collaboratively, participating asset owners and managers can wield more influence than through solo engagements, while saving time and resources.

ENGAGEMENT SCOPE

Through ISS ESG's Norm-Based Engagement, participating investors can focus on companies that are assessed under ISS ESG Norm-Based Research to be involved in alleged or verified severe, systematic, or systemic failures to respect international norms. The engagements are categorised under the four United Nations Global Compact areas of human rights, labour rights, environment, and anti-corruption. Each engagement is identified by one or several specific topics within these areas, e.g., union rights, workplace discrimination, health and safety, child labour and forced labour within the labour rights norm area. Participating investors have the option to opt in or out of each individual company engagement.

ENGAGEMENT PROCESS

The engagement is preceded by in-depth research and fact-finding dialogues with companies and stakeholders through ISS ESG Norm-Based Research. Once a company is identified to be involved in a relevant controversy it is considered for Norm-Based Engagement, which is conducted on a rolling quarterly basis. Through these feasibility studies, ISS ESG identifies gaps in company disclosure and assesses whether investor dialogue is an appropriate means to reach the goals set by the participating investors. Influential factors include an estimation of the company's level of responsibility, mitigating steps it has taken to mitigate the possible failure to respect a norm, and availability of both stakeholder and expert sources to facilitate constructive dialogue.

The engagement dialogue is initiated through letters to companies, sent by ISS ESG on behalf of participating investors. Dialogue may be conducted in writing or through calls and meetings, facilitated by ISS ESG. Some companies require repeated follow-ups to respond. Should the company remain unresponsive, enquiries are escalated to the CEO and the Board. Once every effort has been made to engage both Investor Relations and a company's Executive Management, the feasibility of engagement is re-evaluated.

ENGAGEMENT OUTCOMES

At the outset of each engagement, clear and actionable goals are defined within four key categories: disclosure, implementation, remediation and termination. Information provided by the company through the course of the engagement dialogue is assessed against the goals. ISS ESG also assesses the company's quality of participation in the engagement. Where the goals have been fulfilled and the controversy – or the risk thereof – is assessed to have been resolved, the engagement is closed. If there is insufficient information to determine whether the goals have been fulfilled, the engagement may be suspended pending developments in the controversy or the disclosure of further information by the company and may subsequently be extended. Alternatively, where there is a poor outlook for the achievement of goals for the engagement, the dialogue may be discontinued.






STATISTICS FOR ENGAGEMENT INITIATED IN Q1 2024

In Q1 2024, ISS ESG initiated Norm-Based Engagement on behalf of signatory investors with 25 companies, covering 42 individual ESG topics. Of these 25 companies, five were Red flagged and the remainder Amber flagged, according to ISS ESG's Norm-Based Research methodology. By 31 March 2024, ISS ESG had received responses from 9 of the 25 companies to which investor enquiries had been sent on 16 February 2024. This constitutes an overall response rate of 32%. The statistics presented below are based on the companies with which engagement was initiated in Q1 2024.

NOTABLE ENGAGEMENT ACTIVITY IN Q1 2024

The cases below are examples of notable Norm-Based Engagement activity carried out on behalf of participating investors in Q1 2024.

Pan American Silver Corp.	ISIN CA6979001089
THEMES Indigenous rights	LOCATION Guatemala

In Q4 2023, ISS ESG shared a letter with **Pan American Silver Corp.** on behalf of participating investors regarding the company's indigenous rights controversy at the El Escobal mine in Guatemala.

In a written response to ISS ESG's investor enquiry in February 2024, the company shared that, in October 2022, the second phase of the consultation process was launched and that, to date, eight meetings have been held. It further shared that the Xinka Parliament of Guatemala made several visits to the Escobal site to verify the information, for which the Ministry of Energy and Mines (MEM) and the Ministry of Natural Resources provided external consultants to support the Xinka People and that the MEM provides updates on the process through a webpage dedicated to the consultation process for Escobal. Regarding its measures to strengthen its commitment to free, prior, and informed consent, the company shared that in 2021, it created a Social Sustainability Policy, which includes specific commitments regarding indigenous peoples, mine closure, resettlement, water use, and cultural heritage, and sets out guidelines that aim to recognise and respect the rights, cultural values, beliefs, knowledge, and traditions of indigenous peoples present in the areas where the company operates. Regarding its grievance processes, the company shared a section of its 2022 Sustainability Report where it shares details about its policies, grievances received, and next steps regarding its community and indigenous relations, and further stated that community members can submit questions, requests, concerns, and/or grievances in person or via various channels, and if there is an objection or disagreement to the proposed response, the case escalates to an appeal process that involves the mine's senior management. It further shared that the process is evaluated through a social audit system and periodical checks with the team and the management system data centre, and that it provides opportunities to its users to give feedback.

ACTIVITY SUMMARY

Based on the information Pan American Silver provided in this engagement dialogue, the company was assessed to have made positive progress towards the engagement goals of disclosure of relevant information, implementation of relevant policies, remedial action, and termination of problematic practice. The company was also assessed to have demonstrated an excellent quality of participation in this engagement dialogue. ISS ESG continues to monitor the efficacy of the company's remediation measures.

United States

In Q4 2023, ISS ESG shared a letter with **Koninklijke Philips NV** on behalf of participating investors regarding the company's consumer health and safety controversy in the United States (U.S.).

In written responses to ISS ESG's investor enquiry in February and March 2024, the company shared links to the latest information on the status of recall, testing, and litigation, its portal for assisting patients and its FAQ documents for patients and investors. It disclosed that it has completed the remediation of more than 99% of sleep therapy devices and that the remediation of ventilators is ongoing; that it has agreed with the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) to implement additional testing and aims to finalise recall and testing as well as to manage the litigation and the U.S. Department of Justice investigation. The company further shared its progress regarding its Patient Safety & Quality strategy, which includes upgrading critical systems and data integration, ongoing regulatory and compliance reviews, and a €350 million investment in the strategy for the 2023-2025 period. Regarding the FDA's Class I recalls due to issues in certain reworked machines, the company stated that it is notifying customers and has not received reports of patient harm.

ACTIVITY SUMMARY

Based on the information Philips provided in this engagement dialogue, the company was assessed to have made positive progress towards the engagement goal of implementation of relevant policies. The company was also assessed to have demonstrated a good quality of participation in this engagement dialogue. ISS ESG continues to monitor the efficacy of the company's remediation measures.
