

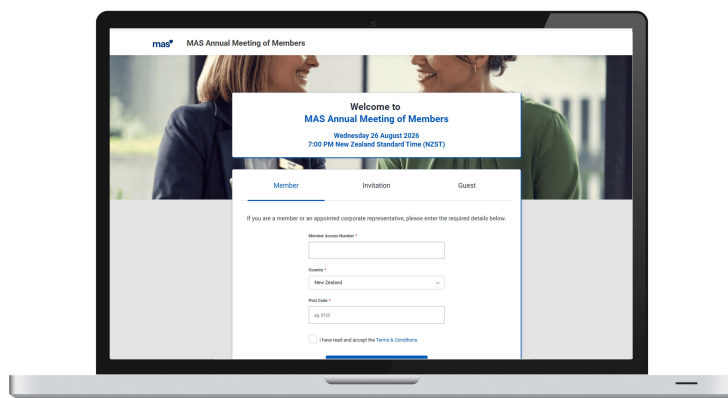
HOW TO PARTICIPATE IN THE ONLINE MAS ANNUAL MEETING 2026

Attending the meeting online

Our online meeting provides you the opportunity to participate online using your smartphone, tablet or computer.

If you choose to attend online you will be able to view a live webcast of the meeting, ask questions and (if you're a Full Member) submit your votes in real time.

You will need the latest version of Chrome, Safari or Edge. Please ensure your browser is compatible.

Access

Access the online meeting at <https://meetnow.global/mas>, and select the required meeting. Click 'JOIN MEETING NOW'.

If you are a Full Member:

Select 'Member' on the login screen and enter your Member Access Number (which you would have received in the original email or letter sent to you advising you of the Annual Meeting) and your Post Code. If you are outside New Zealand, enter your Member Access Number and simply select your country from the drop down box instead of the Post Code. Accept the Terms and Conditions and click Continue.

If you are an Associate Member:

Select Guest on the login screen. As a guest, you will be prompted to complete all the relevant fields including title, first name, last name and email address.

Please note as an Associate Member, you will be able to ask questions but not vote at the Meeting

If you are a proxy holder:

You will receive an email invitation the day before the meeting to access the online meeting. Click on the link in the invitation to access the meeting.

Navigation



When successfully authenticated, the home screen will be displayed. You can watch the webcast, vote (if you are a Full Member), ask questions, and view meeting materials in the documents folder. The image highlighted blue indicates the page you have active.

The webcast will appear and begin automatically once the meeting has started.



Voting

Please note, only 'Full Members' (registered medical practitioners, dentists or vets) can vote. Resolutions will be put forward once voting is declared open by the Chair. Once the voting has opened, the resolution and voting options will appear.

To vote, simply select your voting direction from the options shown on screen. You can vote for all resolutions at once or by each resolution.

Your vote has been cast when the green tick appears. To change your vote, select 'Change Your Vote'.



Q&A

Any Member (Full or Associate) or proxy attending the meeting remotely is entitled to ask a question.

Select the Q&A tab and type your question into the box at the bottom of the screen and press 'send'.
